Standing For Renters' Rights

About Law Center for Better Housing

LCBH is the only legal aid nonprofit in Chicago that focuses solely on housing justice issues. With your support, we preserve affordable housing, expand renters' rights, and prevent homelessness.

In 2025, LCBH's direct and virtual services helped nearly 17,000 households across 77 Chicago community areas and throughout suburban Cook County at every phase of the eviction process.

To meet the growing demand for our services and limit barriers to renters' future housing, we strive to remedy housing issues before an eviction is filed. Rentervention, our free online chatbot, helped nearly 12,000 renters identify problems in their units, draft letters to their landlords, and learn more about their rights last year, enabling our staff attorneys to focus on renters with more complex legal matters.

When you sponsor LCBH, you join us in leading the charge to make Chicago's eviction process more equitable. Inside eviction court, LCBH serves renters through the Cook County Early Resolution Program (ERP) and the Right to Counsel Program. What used to be a last resort before displacement, now serves as a venue with resources like free legal aid and emergency rental assistance to help renters avoid homelessness and make landlords whole.

As our partner, you strengthen our ability to reach households in communities with high eviction rates and support initiatives that relentlessly advocate for people at risk of homelessness. Working together, we can make Chicago more equitable.
